Commute Friendly WNC

Go Mountain Commuting is launching Commute Friendly WNC, a free certification program for employers, workplaces, and college campuses that take an active role in supporting multimodal employees, students, & visitors. It is a program that recognizes, celebrates, and encourages those organizations that go the extra mile to promote ways of getting around our community that reduce traffic congestion and improve air quality. (That means carpooling, vanpooling, public transit, biking, walking, and even remote work!) Organizations can be certified as Bronze, Silver, or Gold levels of commute friendliness, and unlock great benefits for participating. Prioritization

The FBRMPO MPO Board recently finalized its selection of projects for submission through SPOT 8.0. Projects submitted under SPOT include aviation, rail, highway, bike & pedestrian, and public transportation infrastructure. SPOT 8.0 refers to the prioritization process that guides the development of the 2028-2037 STIP which serves as the main vehicle for transportation improvement funding in the state as set by the **State** Transportation Investments (STI) Law. Projects submitted by the MPO to SPOT are taken from existing plans and studies across the region. A list of projects being submitted can be found here.

Managed Lanes

At the September meeting, the MPO Board examined converting a widening project (I-6054) on I-40 between Exit 44 (in Buncombe County) and Exit 27 (in Haywood County) into a tolled, managed lanes project to improve congestion, reliability, and funding viability. The Board voted to continue deliberations on the possible treatment over the next couple of meetings, the project being considered for funding in this round of prioritization. FHWA has more information on managed lanes and other treatments available here.



Approved by the MPO Board in September, *Elevate 2050* is the long-range transportation plan that lays out how our region will invest in roads, transit, and greenways over the next 25 years. It highlights major projects to keep people and goods moving safely and efficiently as the population grows. The plan includes more than \$9 billion in transportation improvements, from highway widenings to expanded greenway connections.

Week Without Driving The Week Without Driving is a nation-wide event meant to draw attention to the 1/3 of people in the United States who do not have the ability to drive. Go Mountain Commuting and Mountain True partnered to plan the Asheville Public Transit Forum and the Asheville Recyclery Open House, to highlight multimodal resources in our community. 
